An Act to amend the "Electoral Act."

[Assented to, 30th November, 1878.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to postpone the preparations for and the formation of fresh electoral rolls about to be formed in the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-nine until the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty, and to make provision that the rolls at present in force shall continue until the thirtieth day of September, one thousand eight hundred and eighty—Be it therefore Enacted by the Governor of the province of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly of the said province, in this present Parliament assembled, as follows:

Preamble.

1. That the electoral rolls for the several electoral districts, and the electoral roll for the said province at present in force, shall remain in force, with such alterations and additions as may from time to time be made therein, pursuant to the provision of the "Electoral Act," until the thirtieth day of September, in the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty.

2. All the various acts by the said Act required to be done in the preparation of fresh electoral rolls in the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-nine, and the various notices required to be given and published, and all other matters and things whatsoever required to be done or performed by the said "Electoral Act" for the formation of the said electoral rolls in the year one thousand eight hundred

hundred and seventy-nine, shall be done in the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty in lieu thereof.
