## No. 49 of 1978

An Act to amend the Racing Act, 1976.

[Assented to 13th April, 1978]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Racing Act Amendment Act, 1978". Short titles.
- (2) The Racing Act, 1976, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".
- (3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Racing Act, 1976-1978".
  
2. This Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation. Commence-  
ment.
  
3. Section 27 of the principal Act is amended—
  - (a) by striking out from subsection (1) the word "five" and inserting in lieu thereof the word "six" ; Amendment of  
principal Act,

Constitution  
of Board.
  - (b) by striking out from subsection (1) the word "and" occurring between paragraphs (c) and (d);
  - and
  - (c) by inserting in subsection (1) the following word and paragraph:—
    - and
    - (e) one shall be nominated by the Greyhound Owners, Trainers and Breeders' Association of South Australia, Incorporated.
