An Act to revive the operation of certain of the provisions of the Mining Act Amendment Act, 1931, and for incidental purposes.

[Assented to 23rd October, 1941.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Mining Act Amendment Act, 1941". Short titles.

(2) The Mining Act, 1930-1931, as amended by this Act and by the Mining (Petroleum) Act, 1940, may be cited as the "Mining Act, 1930-1941".

2. Section 12 of the Mining Act Amendment Act, 1931, is repealed and from the passing of this Act— Repeal of s. 12 of Mining Act Amendment Act, 1931.

- (a) the provisions of sections 2 to 7 (both inclusive), 9 and 11 of the Mining Act Amendment Act, 1931, shall be deemed to be revived and shall be of full force and effect;
- (b) the Mining on Private Property Act, 1909, and the Mining on Private Property Act Amendment Act, 1916, are repealed.
