An Act to amend the Road Traffic Act, 1961-1979.

[Assented to 17th April, 1980]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Road Traffic Act Amendment Act, 1980". Short titles.

(2) The Road Traffic Act, 1961-1979, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

(3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Road Traffic Act, 1961-1980".

2. This Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation. Commencement.

3. Section 47e of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by striking out paragraph (aa) of subsection (1) and inserting in lieu thereof the following paragraph:—

(aa) has committed an offence against any provision of Part III of this Act of which the driving of a motor vehicle is an element;;

and

(b) by striking out subsection (1a);

Amendment of principal Act, s. 47e—
Police may require alcotest or breath analysis.
