BAKEWELL ROAD PLAYGROUND SUBSIDY.

16.9.72

Cabinet has approved a subsidy for a new children's playground in Bakewell Road, Evandale, the Premier and House of Assembly Member for Norwood, Mr. Don Dunstan, announced today.

The St. Peters Council bought the property at 49 Bakewell Road late last year and is planning to develop it as a children's playground and reserve.

Mr. Dunstan said the Government subsidy of \$1,380 would assist the development of the reserve.

"The property will be newly fenced and will have a wide range of playground and general recreational facilities", he said.

"Equipment will include a joy wheel, horizontal ladder, jungle gym, slides, park seats and benches and a barbeque setting.

"The whole area will be grassed and trees planted."

Mr. Dunstan said he was very pleased that the St. Peters Council was taking a lead in the provision of playing areas more of which were needed throughout the metropolitan area.
