South Australia is a State on the move.

New industries and the expansion of existing ones, new markets for our products, major new community projects, a whole new city on the drawing board, an upsurge in tourism - these are some of the things that make life exciting in South Australia. To name just a few of the many important developments:

- . A major \$300M. petrochemical complex at Redcliff at the head of the Spencer Gulf - a great stimulus to development in the "iron triangle" cities of the industrial north.
- . Current expansion projects in the Elizabeth-Salisbury area outside Adelaide worth \$4M. - from cable making to clothing factories.
- . A \$40M. refinery being built by Mobil Oil Australia Ltd. near Adelaide.
- . A \$1M. program by the engineering firm Clyde Industries Ltd. for the manufacture of diesel electric locomotives relocating plant from New South Wales.
- . Big expansion scheme by leading South Australian winemakers Penfolds Wines Ltd. and Orlando Wines Ltd. involving millions of dollars.
- . A \$5.5M. expansion plan by Coca-Cola Bottlers Ltd.

Our location midway between the markets of the eastern States and the expanding west, means we are ideally placed to obtain further development.
