An Act for authorising the Remission of Rent and Renewal Fines due from certain Mineral Lessees of the Crown in the Province of South Australia.

[Assented to, 30th November, 1878.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to authorise the Governor to remit Preamble.
certain rents and renewal fines due in respect of the mineral leases of the Crown hereinafter mentioned, and to authorise the renewals of certain mineral leases, and to forfeit certain other mineral leases, as hereinafter mentioned—Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of the Province of South Australia, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly of the said province, in this present Parliament assembled, as follows:

1. It shall be lawful for the Governor to remit payment of the rent now due in respect of the leases enumerated in the First Schedule hereto: Provided that such remission shall be applied for within six months from the passing hereof by a notice in writing to the Commissioner of Crown Lands and Immigration: And provided also that no such remission shall exceed the amount of two years' rent payable under such leases respectively. Certain rents may be remitted.

2. It shall be lawful for the Governor to repay to the persons mentioned in the Second Schedule hereto, such amount as they shall respectively have paid for rent accrued since the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-six, in respect of the several leases held by them and mentioned in the said Schedule: Provided that such repayment shall be applied for within six months from the passing of this Act. Certain rents may be paid to lessees.

3. It

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Renewal fines may be remitted.

3. It shall be lawful for the Governor to remit payment of the fines which are now payable for the renewal of the leases enumerated in the Third Schedule hereto, and to repay any such fines as have already been paid: Provided that application for such remission or repayment shall be made within six months from the passing of this Act.

Certain leases to be forfeited.

4. Notwithstanding anything in "The Mineral Leases Act of 1867" or elsewhere provided, all leases mentioned in the Fourth Schedule hereto, and in respect of which any rent shall be in arrear and unpaid on the 30th June, 1879, shall thereupon absolutely determine and become forfeited, and the land included therein shall revert to the Crown.

In the name and on behalf of Her Majesty, I hereby assent to this Bill.
