An Act to further amend the Public Service Act, 1916,
and for other purposes.

[Assented to, October 6th, 1920.]

BE it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia,
with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as
follows :

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Public Service Act Amend- Short titles.
ment Act, 1920."
