**An Act to amend the Art Gallery Act, 1939-1978.**

*[Assented to 22nd November, 1979]*

**BE IT ENACTED** by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

**Short titles.**

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Art Gallery Act Amendment Act, 1979".

(2) The Art Gallery Act, 1939-1978, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

(3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Art Gallery Act, 1939-1979".

2. Section 11 of the principal Act is amended—

- (a) by inserting in subsection (1) after the passage "chairman of the board" the passage "and one member to be the deputy chairman of the board";
- (b) by striking out from subsection (2) the passage "The member" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "A member";
- (c) by inserting in subsection (2) after the word "chairman" wherever it occurs the passage "or deputy chairman";
- (d) by inserting in subsection (3) after the word "chairman" wherever it occurs the passage "or deputy chairman";
- (e) by inserting in subsection (4) after the word "chairman" wherever it occurs the passage "or deputy chairman".

and

(f) by inserting after subsection (4) the following subsection:—

(5) In the absence of the chairman from the duties of his office, the deputy chairman shall exercise the powers and discharge the duties of the chairman.

3. Section 12 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by striking out from subsection (1) the passage “, if present,” and inserting in lieu thereof the passage “or, in his absence, the deputy chairman,”;

and

(b) by inserting in subsection (2) after the passage “the chairman” the passage “and the deputy chairman”.
