An Act to amend the Motor Vehicles Act, 1959-1981.

[Assented to 15 October 1981]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Motor Vehicles Act Amendment Act (No. 4), 1981". Short title.

(2) The Motor Vehicles Act, 1959-1981, is in this Act referred to as "the principal Act".

(3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Motor Vehicles Act, 1959-1981".

2. Section 125 of the principal Act is amended by striking out from subsection (3) the passage "in a case where that other claim was in respect of an insured liability, unless the negotiations or proceedings in respect of the firstmentioned claim were conducted or controlled by the insurer who insured the liability in respect of which the other claim was made, or by a person acting with the authority of that insurer". Amendment of s. 125—
Power of insurer to deal with claims against insured.
