An Act to amend the Food and Drugs Act, 1908-1972.

[Assented to 12th February, 1976]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Food and Drugs Act Amendment Act, 1975-1976". Short titles.

(2) The Food and Drugs Act, 1908-1972, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

(3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Food and Drugs Act, 1908-1976".

2. This Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation. Commencement.

3. Section 15 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by striking out from subsection (6) the passage "two auditors" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "an auditor";

(b) by striking out from subsection (6) the passage ", except for the first year, when one shall retire by lot" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "and shall in the month of December in each year audit the accounts of the county board";

and

(c) by striking out from subsection (7) the passage "and shall publish in the *Government Gazette*, within one month of the yearly audit, an abstract of the receipts and expenditure as allowed by the auditors,".

Amendment of principal Act, s. 15—
Constitution of county districts.
