An Act to increase by fifteen per centum the duty payable under the Succession Duties Act, 1929, during the period of nine months commencing the first day of October, nineteen hundred and thirty-six.

[*Assented to, 1st October, 1936.*]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Succession Duties Act Amendment Act, 1936". Short titles.

(2) The Succession Duties Acts, 1929 to 1935, and this Act may be cited together as the "Succession Duties Acts, 1929 to 1936".

(3) The Succession Duties Act, 1929, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act". No. 1898 of 1929.

2. Section 42 of the principal Act is further amended by adding at the end thereof the following subsection :— Amendment of principal Act, s. 42—

(4) When duty becomes chargeable on any property between the thirtieth day of September, nineteen hundred and thirty-six and the first day of July, nineteen hundred and thirty-seven, the amount of duty payable shall be increased by fifteen per centum of the amount which would be payable except for the operation of this section. Continuance of increased duties.
