An Act to amend the Payment of Members of Parliament Act, 1948-1951.

[Assented to 17th December, 1953.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Payment of Members of Parliament Act Amendment Act, 1953". Short titles.

(2) The Payment of Members of Parliament Act, 1948-1951, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Payment of Members of Parliament Act, 1948-1953".

(3) The Payment of Members of Parliament Act, 1948-1951, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

2. Section 4 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by striking out the words "eleven hundred and fifty" in paragraph (a) thereof and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "fourteen hundred and twenty-five";

(b) by striking out the words "twelve hundred" in paragraph (b) thereof and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "fourteen hundred and seventy-five";

Amendment of principal Act, s. 4—
Payments to members.

(c) by striking out the words "twelve hundred and twenty-five" in paragraph (c) thereof and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "fifteen hundred".

(d) by adding at the end thereof the following subsection (the previous part of section 4 being read as subsection (1) thereof):—

(2) Every member of Parliament who is a Minister of the Crown shall be entitled to payment for his services in the discharge of his parliamentary duties at the rate of two hundred and seventy-five pounds a year, in addition to his salary as a Minister of the Crown.

3. Section 5 of the principal Act is amended by inserting after the word "hundred" in the fourth and the fifth lines in each case the words "and twenty-five".

Commencement
of Act.

4. This Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on the first day of July, nineteen hundred and fifty-three.
