An Act to amend the Licensing Act, 1967.

[Assented to 17 November 1983]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short title.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Licensing Act Amendment Act (No. 2), 1983".

(2) The Licensing Act, 1967, is in this Act referred to as "the principal Act".

Commencement.

2. This Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on the thirty-first day of August, 1983.

Amendment of
s. 66b—
Late night permit.

3. Section 66b of the principal Act is amended by inserting after subsection (9) the following subsections:

(10) Subject to subsection (11), no application for a late night permit shall be granted after the commencement of the Licensing Act Amendment Act (No. 2), 1983.

(11) An application for a late night permit may be granted after the commencement of the Licensing Act Amendment Act (No. 2), 1983, if—

(a) the application is made in respect of licensed premises for which a late night permit was in force within the period of three months immediately preceding the date of the application;

(b) the permit, if granted, would operate in respect of a part of the licensed premises that is no greater in area than that part of the licensed premises to which the former permit related;

and

(c) the permit, if granted, would impose conditions on the licensee that are at least as stringent as those imposed by the former permit.
