**An Act to amend the Consumer Transactions Act, 1972-1982.**

*[Assented to 14 April 1983]*

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Consumer Transactions Act Amendment Act, 1983". Short titles.

(2) The Consumer Transactions Act, 1972-1982, is in this Act referred to as "the principal Act".

(3) the principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Consumer Transactions Act, 1972-1983".

2. This Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation. Commencement.

3. Section 9 of the principal Act is amended by inserting after subsection (2) the following subsection: Amendment of s. 9—  
Implied warranty in consumer contract for provision of services.

(3) This section does not apply to a consumer contract providing for the carrying out of domestic building work within the meaning of the Builders Licensing Act, 1967-1983.
