An Act to amend the Wild Dogs Acts, 1912 to 1928.

[Assented to, September 5th, 1929.]

BE it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Wild Dogs Act Amendment Act, 1929". Short title.

(2) The Wild Dogs Acts, 1912 to 1928, and this Act may be cited together as the "Wild Dogs Acts, 1912 to 1929".

(3) The Wild Dogs Act, 1912, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act". No. 1102 of 1912.

2. (1) Section 7 of the principal Act (as amended by section 4 of the Wild Dogs Act Amendment Act, 1919) is further amended by striking out the word "Four" in the last line thereof and by inserting in lieu thereof the word "Two". Amendment of principal Act, s. 7—Subsidies to the Fund.

(2) The amendment made by this section shall be deemed to have come into effect on the first day of January, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine.

3. Section 8 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the word "Four" in the eighth line thereof and by inserting in lieu thereof the word "Five". Amendment of principal Act, s. 8—Rate of interest on advance.
