An Act to amend the Homes Act, 1941-1950.

[Assented to 11th October, 1951.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Homes Act Amendment Act, 1951". Short titles.

(2) The Homes Act, 1941-1950, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Homes Act, 1941-1951".

(3) The Homes Act, 1941-1950, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

2. Section 7 of the principal Act (as amended by section 3 of the Homes Act Amendment Act, 1947, and section 2 of the Homes Act Amendment Act, 1949) is amended by striking out the words "one thousand five hundred" in paragraph (a) thereof and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "one thousand seven hundred and fifty".
