## REVOCATION OF DUMPING GAZETTALS

The following Customs Tariff (Dumping and Subsidies) Act Notices have been revoked:

- (a) Notice No.3(1973) published in Commonwealth of Australia Gazette No.78 of 29 June 1973 relating to styrene butadiene latexes. Revoked by Notice No.28 (1974), operates on 29 April 1974.
- (b) Notice No.67 published in Commonwealth of Australia Gazette No.52 of 6 June 1968 relating to cotton bed sheets, pillow and bolster cases, and woven cotton fabrics therefor. Revoked by Notice No.29 (1974), operative on 29 April 1974.
- (c) Notice No.51 published in Commonwealth of Australia Gazette No.40 of 4 May 1967 relating to hoods and capelines. Revoked by Notice No.30(1974), operative on 29 April 1974.
- (d) Notice No.10 (1973) published in the Australian Government Gazette No.134 of 27 September 1973 relating to plasticizers of the polyester type. Revoked by Notice No.31(1974), operative on 29 April 1974.

The revocation notices will appear in the Australian Government Gazette of 7 May 1974.
