PRESS STATEMENT.

FROM: THE PREMIER (MR. DUNSTAN)

The Government has agreed to subsidise the cost of building a laundry, office and barbecue at the Meningie Caravan Park, the Premier and Minister of Development, Mr. Dunstan, announced today.

Mr. Dunstan said that he expected the work to be completed by mid-December and that the subsidy would be on a one for one basis up to a maximum of \$1,750.

"The work is required to upgrade the standard of the caravan park and meet the public demand for better facilities."

Mr. Dunstan said that the subsidy was in line with the Government's policy of encouraging the development of the quality of tourist facilities in the Lakes area.
