PRESS RELEASE FROM THE ACTING PREMIER, MR CORCORAN.

4.12.73

The Acting Premier, Mr Corcoran, today sent an urgent telegram to all South Australian Senators asking them to support the Federal Government's measure to provide funds to meet the needs of education in South Australia.

The telegram read:

"I urge you to support the Government measure to provide funds to meet the needs of education in South Australia. In any re-scheduling S.A. is clearly worse off than any other State. Apart from that the Australian Government has a clear mandate from the Australian people for this measure and on that understanding the S.A. Government has already committed expenditure for the period January to June 1974 of approximately \$5 million.
