An Act to amend the Off-Shore Waters (Application of Laws) Act, 1976

[Assented to 3rd April, 1980]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Off-Shore Waters (Application of Laws) Act Amendment Act, 1980". Short titles.

(2) The Off-Shore Waters (Application of Laws) Act, 1976, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

(3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Off-Shore Waters (Application of Laws) Act, 1976-1980".

2. This Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation. Commencement.

3. Section 3 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by striking out the passage "Notwithstanding any other provision of this Act" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "Subject to subsection (2) of this section,";

and

(b) by inserting after the present contents as amended by this section (which are hereby designated subsection (1) thereof) the following subsection:—

(2) This section does not operate to apply criminal laws within the meaning of the Crimes (Offences at Sea) Act, 1980, to any act, omission, circumstance or state of affairs to which those laws apply by virtue of that Act.

4. Section 4 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by striking out the passage "Notwithstanding any other provision of this Act" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "Subject to subsection (2) of this section,";

Application of law of State to persons connected with the State, etc. in off-shore waters.

and

(b) by inserting after the present contents as amended by this section (which are hereby designated subsection (1) thereof) the following subsection:—

(2) This section does not operate to apply criminal laws within the meaning of the Crimes (Offences at Sea) Act, 1980, to any act, omission, circumstance or state of affairs to which those laws apply by virtue of that Act.
