An Act to amend the Swine Compensation Act,
1936-1971.

[Assented to 30th March, 1972]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Swine Compensation Act Amendment Act, 1972".

(2) The Swine Compensation Act, 1936-1971, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Swine Compensation Act, 1936-1972".

(3) The Swine Compensation Act, 1936-1971, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

ment.

2. This Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation.

Interpretation.

3. Section 4 of the principal Act is amended by striking out from the definition of "disease" the passage "swine fever,".

Amendment of

s. 4a—
Proclamation
of disease, etc.

4. Section 4a of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by striking out from subsection (2) the passage "proclaimed as such by a previous proclamation";

(b) by inserting in subsection (2) after the passage "this Act" first occurring the passage "and upon the publication of that proclamation that disease shall cease to be a disease as defined in section 4 of this Act";

(c) by striking out from subsection (2) the second sentence therein;

and

(d) by inserting immediately after subsection (2) the following subsection:—

(3) At any time after a disease has, pursuant to a proclamation under this section, ceased to be a disease as defined in section 4 of this Act, the Governor may by proclamation under subsection (1) of this section declare that disease to be a disease for the purposes of this Act.

5. Section 8 of the principal Act is amended by striking out from subsection (4) paragraph (d) thereof.
