An Act to permit Juries to separate in cases of Felony.

[*Assented to, December 9th, 1905.*]

BE it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

1. This Act may be cited as "The Juries Separation Act, 1905." Short title of Act.

2. Upon the trial of any person for a felony other than murder, treason, or treason felony, the Court may, if it see fit, at any time before the Jury consider their verdict, permit the Jury to separate in the same way as the Jury upon the trial of any person for misdemeanor are now permitted to separate. Separation of juries in cases of felony. 60 & 61 Vict., c. 18.
