NEW MUNICIPAL TRAMWAYS TRUST CHAIRMAN.

Mr. A.M. Ramsay, C.B.E., B.Sc., General Manager of the South Australian Housing Trust was today appointed in Executive Council to be Chairman of the Municipal Tramways Trust for a term of five years.

In making the announcement, the Premier, Mr. Dunstan, said that Mr. Barker had rendered great service to the public over many years in his capacity as Chairman of the Trust, particularly so as he had carried out the duties of this office without remuneration.

"The Government's view is that it is essential to co-ordinate the development of public transport in the metropolitan area together with housing development, and these factors influenced the Government in its decision to appoint Mr. Ramsay as the new Chairman," said Mr. Dunstan.

Mr. Ramsay has retired from the National Gallery and the State Library Boards in order to enable him to carry out his new duties as Chairman of the Municipal Tramways Trust and a member of the Australian Broadcasting Commission.
