An Act to amend the South Australian Health Commission Act, 1975-1981.

[Assented to 14 April 1983]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "South Australian Health Commission Act Amendment Act, 1983". Short titles.

(2) The South Australian Health Commission Act, 1975-1981, is in this Act referred to as "the principal Act".

(3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "South Australian Health Commission Act, 1975-1983".

2. Section 11 of the principal Act is amended by striking out from subsection (5) the passage "be so appointed only for the balance of that term" and substituting the passage— Amendment of s. 11—
Removal from and vacancies of office.

"be appointed—

(a) in the case of a person appointed to replace the Chairman of the Commission, for a term not exceeding seven years;

and

(b) in the case of a person appointed to replace a part-time member of the Commission, only for the balance of the term of his predecessor."
