An Act to amend the South Australian Housing Trust Act, 1936-1965.

[Assented to 21st October, 1971]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "South Australian Housing Trust Act Amendment Act, 1971".

(2) The South Australian Housing Trust Act, 1936-1965, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "South Australian Housing Trust Act, 1936-1971".

(3) The South Australian Housing Trust Act, 1936-1965, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

General powers
of the trust.

2. Section 20 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by striking out from subsection (1) the word "and" immediately following paragraph (h);

and

(b) by inserting in subsection (1) immediately after paragraph (i) the following passage:—

and

(j) exercise any power conferred on the trust by or under any other Act.
