NEW CABINET POSITIONS.

The Premier, Mr. Dunstan, announced today the allocation of portfolios to the two new Government Ministers as well as details of other Cabinet changes.

Mr. Dunstan said that Mr. Peter Duncan would be the new Attorney-General. Mr. Duncan would also become Minister of Prices and Consumer Affairs and would take over from the Premier the administration of the Classification of Publications Act and the Film Classification Act.

The other new Minister, Mr. Don Simmons, will be Minister for the Environment.

In other changes, the Premier will take over the Industrial Development Division and Mr. Hugh Hudson will take over administration of the State Planning Authority.

The Premier added that the only Minister to be sworn in today would be Peter Duncan. The other changes would take place next week after Mr. Broomhill had resigned. Mr. Broomhill will then become the new Government Whip.
