Inspectors for Builders Licensing Board

Executive Council has approved the appointment of two inspectors for the Builders Licensing Board, the Secretary of the Board, Mr. J.N. Holland, said today.

He said the inspectors, Mr. K.J. Burton and Mr. D.J. Dunstone, are expected to assume their duties within the next few weeks.

They will be concerned primarily with the investigation of complaints about building standards and with ensuring that builders hold the licences necessary under the terms of the Builders Licensing Act.

The Act aims to provide effective protection for home builders in particular, and to ensure that adequate building standards are met.

Mr. Dunstone, 48, has spent some years with the Unley Corporation, first as Building Inspector and then as Assistant Building Surveyor.

Mr. Burton, 38, has had considerable experience in construction supervision and for the last few years has been Production Manager with Lloyds Building Co. Ltd.
