An essential feature of Adelaide which we must retain is that we have an effective city centre. The central city facilities should be used frequently and we should not encourage the city to become a dead heart after 6 p.m.

With the provisions of the new Licensing Act, one would hope that within the city area and close to its shopping and entertainment facilities, there will develop accommodation of the standards now sought by today's travellers.

This \$1/2M. project is an important step in ensuring that this area of the city develops along these lines. These are the first 17 units of a motel, and an additional 40 units with underground parking facilities are planned. Close by are a bowling alley and a night club, and the shopping facilities, theatres and restaurants of Hindley and Rundle Streets are within walking distance.
