There has been some movement in grocery prices in South Australia, and these are being looked at by the Prices Commissioner together with rejected increases in household items of expenditure, particularly groceries.

It certainly has seemed to me that some of the movements in grocery prices have been more than could possibly have been justified by increased costs, and so everyone of these things will have to be carefully looked at.

If members of the public have got cases where they feel that grocery costs have gone up unreasonably I should be grateful if they would report this to the Prices Commissioner so that each case may be looked at.
