HOUSING TRUST RECORD.

26.7.72

A record number of cottage flats for aged pensioners had been built by the Housing Trust in the past twelve months the Premier and Housing Minister, Mr. Dunstan, announced today.

He said that in the year to 30th June the Trust built another 215 cottage flats.

This brought the total number of such units built by the Trust for the aged since 1954 to 1879.

Mr. Dunstan said that during the year the Trust built 2201 houses and flats compared with 2212 the previous year.

Of these 989 were in the metropolitan area, 292 at Elizabeth and Smithfield Plains, and 920 in sixty eight country areas.

Major areas of development were Ingle Farm, Whyalla, Christie Downs, Elizabeth and Smithfield Plains, and Port Augusta.

At present more than 1600 houses are under construction for the Trust.
