## No. 1219.

An Act to vest portions of certain roads in the Crown for certain purposes.

[*Assented to, December 23rd, 1915.*]

**B**E it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

**1.** This Act may be cited as the "Roads (Magill Home and Yatala Quarry) Acquisition Act, 1915." Short title.

**2.** (1) Notwithstanding the provisions of the District Councils Act, 1914, the piece of land delineated in the plan in the First Schedule and therein hatched in black and marked "A", being portion of a public road which, pursuant to the said Act is vested in, and is under the care, control, and management of, the District Council of Campbelltown, is hereby vested for an estate of inheritance in fee simple in His Majesty King George the Fifth and his successors, and shall, from the passing of this Act, cease to be under the care, control, and management of the said District Council and cease to be a public road. Portion of district road, Magill, vested in the Crown for purposes of Magill Home. No. 1182 of 1914.

(2) The said piece of land shall be used for the erection of buildings and improvements in connection with, or otherwise for the purposes of, the Magill Home, in such manner as the Commissioner of Public Works thinks fit.

**3.** (1) Notwithstanding as aforesaid, the piece of land delineated in the plan in the Second Schedule and therein hatched in black and marked "B", being portion of a public road which pursuant to the District Councils Act, 1914, is vested in, and is under the care, control, Portion of district road, Yatala South, vested in the Crown for quarry purposes. control, and management of, the District Council of Yatala South, is hereby vested for an estate of inheritance in fee simple in His Majesty King George the Fifth and his successors, and shall, from the passing of this Act, cease to be under the care, control, and management of the said District Council and cease to be a public road.

(2) The said piece of land is hereby added to and shall form part of the Prison Reserve at the Yatala Labor Prison, and may be used in connection with the said Prison for the purposes of a stone quarry or otherwise for the purposes of the said Prison: Provided that the said piece of land may be dealt with, in all respects, in the same manner as if it were Crown lands reserved pursuant to the Crown Lands Act, 1915.

(3) The Governor may acquire for an estate in fee simple the piece of land delineated in the plan in the Second Schedule and therein hatched in black and marked "C", and may dedicate for a public road such part thereof as he deems convenient for connecting the two pieces of road which are severed in consequence of the operation of this section; and upon such dedication the said part shall be deemed to have been dedicated under the Crown Lands Act, 1915, and may, notwithstanding any provision of the District Councils Act, 1914, be dealt with in all respects accordingly.

In the name and on behalf of His Majesty, I hereby assent to this Bill.

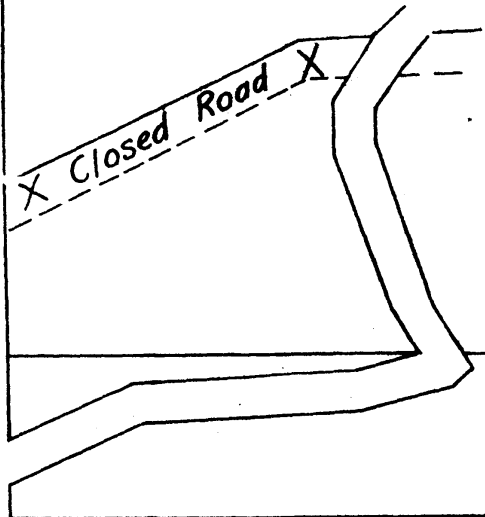
