An Act to amend the Physiotherapists Act, 1945-1964.

[Assented to 24th March, 1966.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Physiotherapists Act Amendment Act, 1965-1966". Short titles.

(2) The Physiotherapists Act, 1945-1964, as amended by this Act may be cited as the "Physiotherapists Act, 1945-1966".

(3) The Physiotherapists Act, 1945-1964, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act. Incorporation.

3. Section 42 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by striking out the words "three guineas" in subsection (1) and inserting in lieu thereof the words "twelve dollars" ;

(b) by striking out the words "without liability to pay any subscription" in the proviso to subsection (1) thereof and inserting in lieu thereof the words "upon payment to the board of an annual fee of three dollars at such time as is prescribed by the regulations" ; and

- (c) by striking out the word "subscriptions" in the fourth line of the proviso to subsection (1) and inserting in lieu thereof the words "the annual subscription prescribed by regulations under this section".
