An Act to amend the Supreme Court Act, 1935-1958.

[Assented to 1st December, 1960.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Supreme Court Act Short titles. Amendment Act (No. 2), 1960".

(2) The Supreme Court Act, 1935-1958, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Supreme Court Act, 1935-1960".

(3) The Supreme Court Act, 1935-1958, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Incorporation. Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.

3. Section 12 of the principal Act is amended by striking out Amendment of principal Act, s. 12. subsection (1) thereof and inserting in lieu thereof the following subsections :—

(1) The salary of the Chief Justice shall be at the rate of six thousand two hundred and fifty pounds a year and the salary of every puisne judge shall be at the rate of five thousand five hundred pounds a year.

(2) The rates of salary as altered by this section shall be deemed to have come into force for all purposes (including contributions for pension and rights to pension) on the first day of July, one thousand nine hundred and sixty.
