An Act to amend the Advances for Homes Act, 1928-1947.

[Assented to 27th October, 1949.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Advances for Homes Act Amendment Act, 1949".

(2) The Advances for Homes Act, 1928-1947, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Advances for Homes Act, 1928-1949".

(3) The Advances for Homes Act, 1928-1947, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

2. (1) Subsection (2) of section 18 of the principal Act (as enacted by section 4 of the Advances for Homes Act Amendment Act, 1944, and amended by subsection (1) of section 6 of the Advances for Homes Act Amendment Act, 1947) is amended by striking out the words "two hundred and fifty" wherever occurring in paragraph (d) and paragraph (e) thereof and by inserting in lieu thereof in every case the words "five hundred".

(2) Subsection (4) of section 18 of the principal Act (as amended by subsection (2) of section 6 of the Advances for Homes Act Amendment Act, 1947) is amended by striking out the words "two hundred and fifty" in the proviso thereto and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "five hundred".

3. Subsection (5) of section 22 of the principal Act (as amended by section 6 of the Advances for Homes Act Amendment Act, 1944, and by section 7 of the Advances for Homes Act Amendment Act, 1947) is amended by striking out the words "two hundred and fifty" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "five hundred".

4. Subsection (2) of section 35 of the principal Act (as amended by section 8 of the Advances for Homes Act Amendment Act, 1944, and by section 8 of the Advances for Homes Act Amendment Act, 1947) is amended by striking out the words "two hundred and fifty" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "five hundred".

5. Subsection (2) of section 40 of the principal Act (as amended by section 9 of the Advances for Homes Act Amendment Act, 1944, and by section 9 of the Advances for Homes Act Amendment Act, 1947) is amended by striking out the words "two hundred and fifty" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "five hundred".
