PRESS STATEMENT.

FROM THE PREMIER (MR. DUNSTAN)

The South Australian Government has agreed to subsidise up to a maximum of \$1,350 improvements at the Morgan Caravan Park, the Premier and Minister of Development (Mr. Dunstan) announced today.

Mr. Dunstan said that it is expected the work will be completed by mid-December and will include 24 new power points, additional lawn area and irrigation system, a new domestic watering system, improvements in the toilet block, concrete paths and general beautification and additional effluent disposal facilities.

He said that the Morgan Council is endeavouring to improve the Morgan Caravan Park to provide facilities of a standard with other caravan parks in the upper Murray area and the Government is pleased to be able to assist this work which is in line with its overall policy of encouraging tourism in the area.
